Position description

This internship is an ideal grounding for developing your career in the sector. Each intern will be exposed to all facets of festival management, including responsibilities covering the administration of the festival, the production of the festival as well as the programming of the festival, and will play a significant role in the success of the Emerging Writers' Festival.

Working closely with the Festival Director, General Manager, Program Coordinator and Production Manager you will:

- Take ownership of an arts management project, taking responsibility for the program development and delivery of a programmed Festival event;
- Assist in the overall development and management of the 2017 Emerging Writers' Festival;
- Assist in the production and delivery of the 2017 Emerging Writers' Festival;
- Attend relevant meetings with EWF stakeholders including project partners, and fortnightly staff meetings; and
- Produce a post-event report.

Conditions

- This position is voluntary. Applicants undertaking the internship as a project requirement of an arts or events management, communications, publishing, editing or writing course will be looked upon favourably.
- Time commitment is half a day a week, with potential extra time leading up to and during the Festival, for a six-month period.
- Actual days/hours per week are to be negotiated with Festival Director. Some work outside of these hours might be necessary, for example, to attend meetings.
- The intern reports to the Festival Director and Program Coordinator.
- The position is located within the Wheeler Centre, Little Lonsdale St, Melbourne with some work off site as required.

Selection Criteria

This position will work best for people who are keen to learn about literary events management, so let us know why this internship would be a great experience for you right now.

- Superb communications skills, both oral and written.
- The ability to respond to direction, and work both independently and as part of a team.
- Ability to commit to a consistent weekly schedule against other work and study commitments, across the entire six-month period, with peak periods in the month before the Festival please let us know about all your competing time commitments.
- An interest in the Festival's mission and target audience.
